1. References:

2. PURPOSE. Environmental Management Policy affirms CCDC GVSC's intent to operate in an environmentally responsible manner and emphasizes continuous improvement of the environmental performance of its products, services, and processes in support of its mission and vision. CCDC GVSC and its management is committed to reducing its environmental footprint while carrying out its mission of developing, integrating, and sustaining the right technology solutions and providing full life cycle engineering support for all manned and unmanned systems across the ground vehicle domain.

3. POLICY. To support CCDC GVSC's EMS, all personnel (government and contractor) will conduct themselves accordingly and perform the following duties:

- a. Continually improve CCDC GVSC's EMS and enhance the environmental performance of all activities, products, and services including areas not subject to regulation.
- b. Ensure compliance with applicable Local, State, and Federal environmental laws, regulations, policies, and all other compliance obligations for which CCDC GVSC subscribes.
- c. Establish objectives and plans to protect the environment through active pollution prevention to counteract adverse effects to the environment where practical.
